

2026 VINNY MARIBITO ONE-PITCH RULES

The entry fee for each player or coach is \$10. This will be collected by each manager and turned into Jeff Bennett before the first game. Any player not paying this amount by that time will be ineligible to play and any coach not paying this amount by that time will be ineligible to coach on the bench or on the field.

The tournament will follow ALL CP Softball rules **EXCEPT:**

1. Non-Runners –

- Each team will have one designated non-runner.
- If a team does not have a non-runner the manager will designate the team's non-runner before the first game.
- All teams must use the same non-runner for all games.
- If a team ends up with 2 non-runners because of an error during the draft (both are qualified non-runners), then the non-runner that was mis-identified as a runner may be run for without causing that runner to be counted as a runner for that player. For example, Team A drafts John Doe as their non-runner, then later in the draft, they are forced to take another non-runner, then they can run for that non-runner w/o being charged with a run for that player.

2. Teams will play with 11 or 12 players in the lineup. If a team has 12 players on their roster, then all players will bat, but one player will sit the bench during each defensive inning. No player is allowed to sit the bench for more than 2 innings in any single game (and not consecutive innings).

3. Pitching Screen – Standard pitching screen options as used in 2026 for CP Softball.

4. Batters will receive only one (1) pitch

POSSIBLE OUTCOMES-

1. if BALL is called batter WALKS
2. if STRIKE is called batter is OUT
3. if batter swings and misses batter is OUT
4. if batter hits a FOUL BALL batter is OUT
5. batter hits a fair ball
6. If batter hits the pitching screen – Dead Ball – No Pitch

2026 VINNY MARIBITO ONE-PITCH RULES

Additional Items:

- home team wears WHITE; away team wear BLUE (have both on hand for quick changes)
- For all the Semi-Finals and Finals on Wednesday – if a game is tied at the end of 7 innings, play until the tie is broken

Standings procedure is:

- teams are ranked in each division by points – win = 2 pts; tie = 1 pt; loss = 0 pts
- two teams in each division with the most points will make the playoffs on Wednesday
- the third-place team in each division will also play on Wednesday
- ties in the standings (not games) will be broken by:
 - 1st – winner of head-to-head game between the two tied teams
 - 2nd – if game was tied, counting all games, the team with the fewest runs allowed (RA) will advance
 - 3rd – if still tied, the winner of a coin flip will advance

All disputes will be resolved by the One Pitch Committee.
