

We have had several inquiries regarding the changes to the men's rules. People have told us that they have studied the rules and can't see what's changed; the answer to that is 'not much'. The changes are minor in nature, mostly to do with wording. Here is a short summary;

#### Men's Rules and Regulations

Previously, there was reference to the Men's Rules Committee and the Men's Playing Rules Committee. There is only one committee, the Men's Rules Committee, and that is now reflected. We have also cleaned up the wording regarding how protests are handled, so that the wording aligns with the process.

#### Men's Playing Rules

The main change here relates to non-runners. The wording now accurately reflects how we deal with non-runners and it has been moved from Batting to Base Running.

#### Men's Player Placement Regulations

The change here is that the throwing requirement now is from home plate to the pitcher's mound, rather than from second base to first base. It is also made clear that the Men's Executive may request that a player be re-rated.
